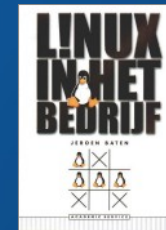

Some examples from history



- The need for high volume traffic
- The need for resilient data connections



High volume traffic

- 1911 US: Long Island Motor Parkway Long Island Motor Parkway
- 1921 US: Federal Aid Highway Act
 - “We the people... need highways” :-)
- 1932 Bonn-Keulen highway
- 1930: NL: We don't need no highways!
- 1937: NL: Den Haag – Zoetermeer ready
- Bottomline: publicly funded infrastructure

Resilient Data Connections



- 1957: Spoetnik → US: Damn, we need a network! → DARPA → start research
- 1968: We have a plan! → Tender
- 29 oktober 1969: First data packet traffic
- 1990 US: end of DARPA funding
- 1991 US: Start of public funding
- Foundation: Everybody pays their part

Where are we now?



- Internet connected software is running the world.
- Internet infrastructure code is open source
- **But what about the next layer?**



Current software market

- Primarily commercial market
- Government is neo-liberal:
 - The market shall handle it
 - The market is the most efficient solution
 - The market makes everything cheaper and better
- Is there nothing else....?

Nothing else mattered....



- Educational research funding
- NLNet foundation: “ It funds those with ideas to fix the internet”
 - Well, if it ain’t broken.....
- NWO: “NWO funds scientific research...”
- Start-ups? Aka “the market”

What do we need?



- We need a way to create software for public benefit.
- Software in the heart of society
- Software for which there is no commercial incentive
 - There is no market (yet)
- Like:
 - Blockchain+GPG (see my other talk)
 - Archiving software for digital assets
 - Converting international software to multi-language
 - Medical big data analysis for rare diseases

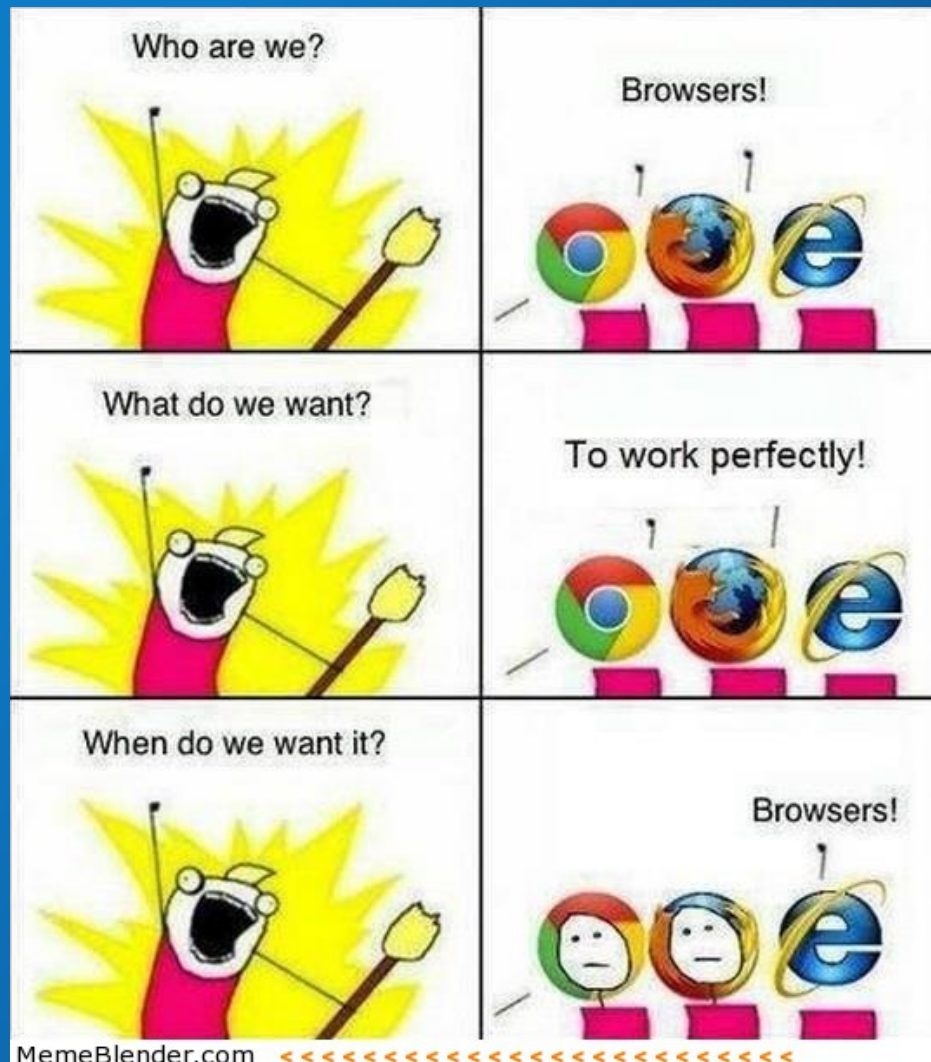
